WESTERN INDIGENOUS NETWORK Snapshot

- Serving 2,910 households on Tribal Lands in NV, UT, NM, AZ, CO, and CA
- Residential-Serving Solar Energy = 14.39 MW*,
 Solar + Storage, WFD, and upgrades
- 28% Project Deployment Technical Assistance
- 72% Financial Assistance for Tribal Communities

WIN SFA: Financial & Technical Assistance for Tribes



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Subawards (Grants) for federally recognized tribes in our 6 state target region of AZ, NM, CO, UT, NV, & CA.
- Geared towards solar PV installs (battery storage) & workforce development, enabling upgrades.
- Loans and gap funding provided through TSAF, Native CDFI Network, and other matchmaking potential.
- Participant support costs for training, WFD, and program participation.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE


- Project development and construction planning

WIN-SFA Pilot Launch in 2025



Tribal Energy Alternatives is proud to announce the launch of the WIN-SFA pilot project phase in May 2025. The pilot phase is geared towards identifying eligible pilot projects within our target states of NM, AZ, UT, CO, NV, & CA. Through the pilot phase, the WIN-SFA team plans on mobilizing temporary mechanisms to better identify and refine existing processes for grant administration, project deployment, outreach, and other areas as defined in our workplan.

*CA will be handled in coordination with our partners and Regional Offices.



WIN SFA Pilot Phase Process

Announcement

May 2025 – Solicit proposals from eligible Federally Recognized Tribes and Tribal organizations in target states for Pilot Project subawards

Application

Two step application process for requesting No-Cost Technical Assistance and developing application proposal: develop workplan, budget, timeline and reporting compliance

Eligibility

Requirements include: Federally Recognized Tribe or Tribal Entity, located in target states, 20% household savings, etc.

Evaluation

Applications evaluated based on readiness, program alignment, risk assessment

Implementation

WIN-SFA subgrants will flow directly to tribes through a contractual agreement. Awards to go out Fall 2025

WIN-SFA Pilot Project: NOFO Terms



NOFO has all relevant information and below are parameters of Eligibility

- Deadlines: Application periods
 - 5/1/25 to 6/30/2025
 - 07/01/2025 to 08/30/2025

- Review timeline
 - 2-week review period after close
 - 4-week information gathering for award agreement

WIN-SFA Pilot Project: Capital Stacking



- Capital Stacking
 - ITC Tax Credits
 - State energy incentives
 - Ownership models
 - Tribes have the option to seek TA on this isseu from TEA and will be evaluated based upon tribes need.
 - Coalition Partners: Alliance for Tribal Clean Energy and Native CDFI Network.


